

Innovations 2010 Creativity Challenge Quilt Version 2 ~ Part 2

Approximate finished size 63 x 63 inches

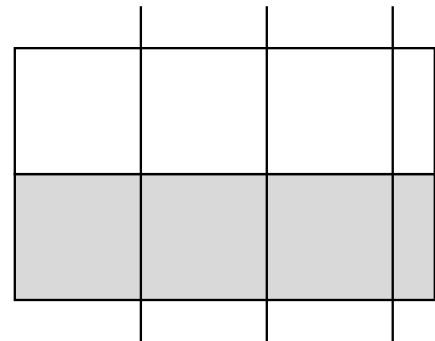

All seams are 1/4 inch and pressed toward dark fabric.

Take a 2 inch x wof background fabric strip and a 2 inch 2wof dark fabric strip and stitch them together along one long edge. Press to dark fabric.

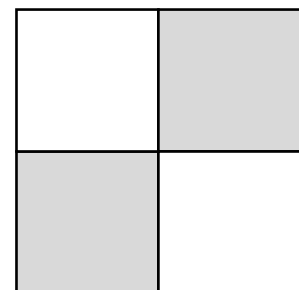
Repeat three more times to make 4 strips.

Cut into 72, 2 inch strips.



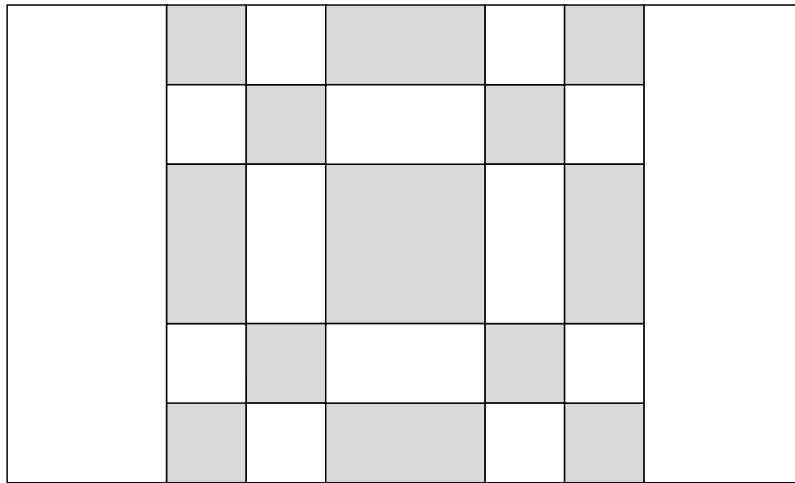
Stitch the pieces together as shown in the illustration at the right to make 36, 4 Patch Blocks.

Place on pile and reserve.



Take the 3½ x wof Background Fabric strips and cut into 36, 3½ x 9½ inch rectangles.

Stitch a rectangle to the opposite sides of the block as shown in the illustration below.
Press as desired.



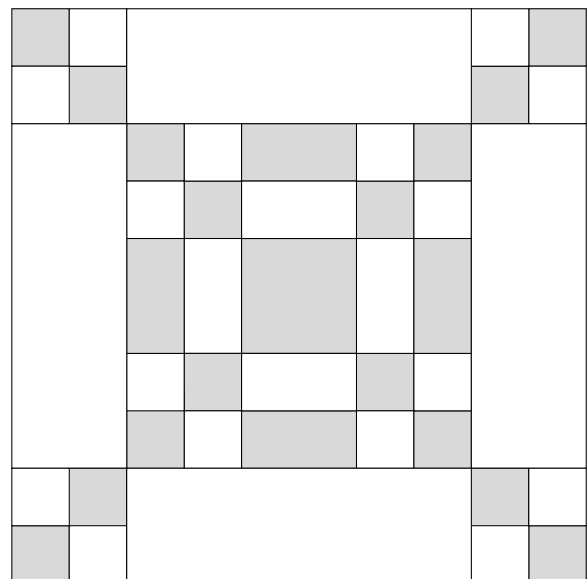
Stitch a 4 Patch Block to the short edges of the remaining Background Fabric rectangles EXACTLY as shown in the illustration below.



Stitch the 4 Patch / Rectangle unit to the top and bottom of the block EXACTLY as shown in the illustration at the right.

Press as desired.

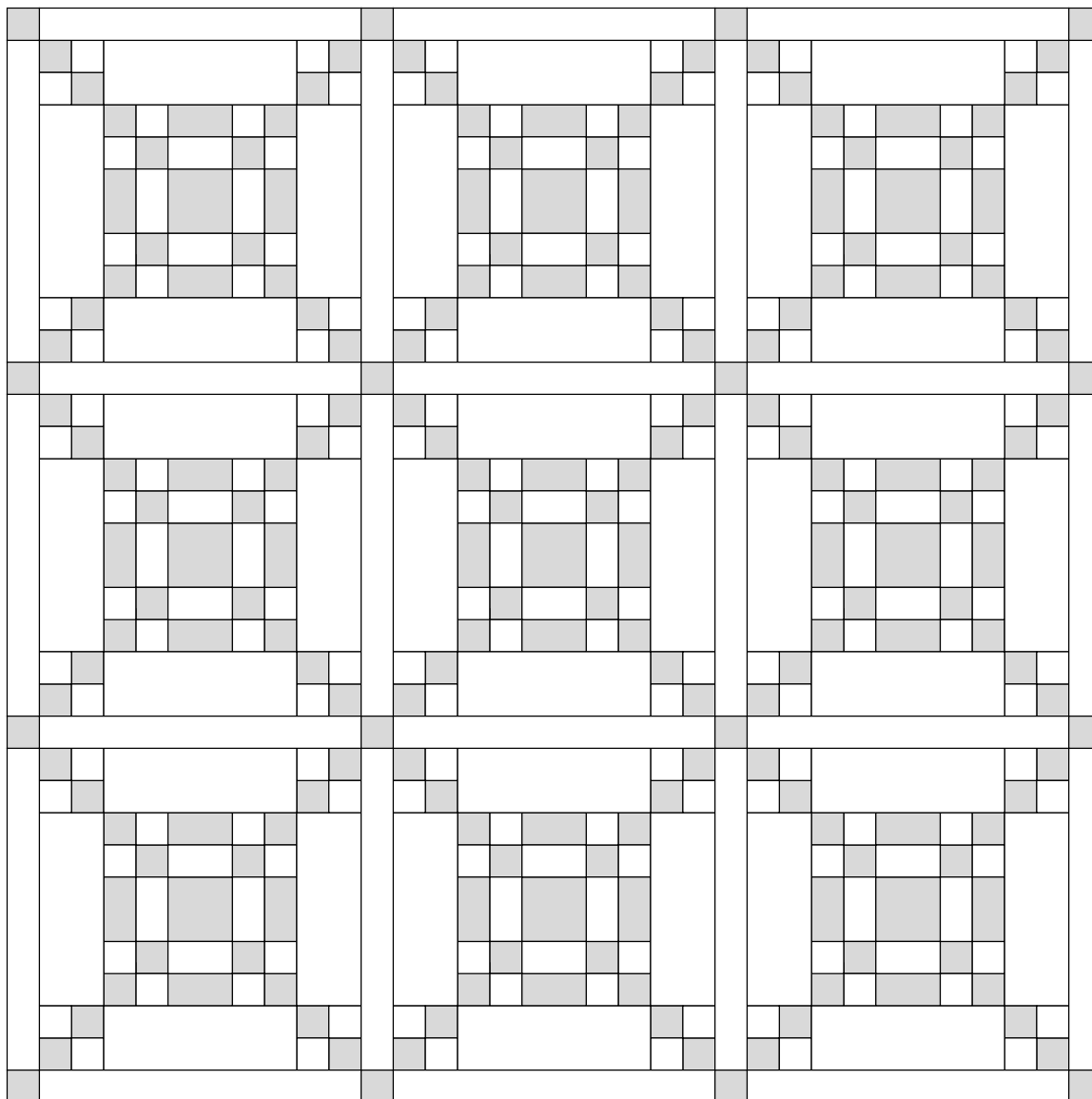
Blocks should measure 15½ inches square.



Take the remaining 2 inch x wof Background Fabric strips and cut into 24, 15½ inch rectangles for the block sashing.

Take the remaining 2 inch x wof Dark Fabric strip and cut into 16, 2 inch squares for cornerstones.

Lay out the blocks, sashing and cornerstones as shown in the illustration below and stitch together to form quilt top.



Border—Stitch the Border Fabric strips together as needed and stitch to the quilt. After the border has been added, the quilt top is completed.
